cigarettes per day during pregnancy can increase the chance of SIDS by up to four times, while smoking more than 20 cigarettes per day can increase the chance by nearly nine times. On days 1-2 Wees: 2 or more per day Poos: 1 or more per day Poo at this stage is called 'meconium' or 'mec' for short It's

Recommended fluid intake for children per day: 1-3 years 1 litre 4-8 years 12 litres 9 years plus 15 litres Your child should be drinking mainly water Fizzy drinks, those that contain caffeine, E numbers, colorants or red berries are known to irritate the bladder and are best avoided The best drink is water
