- Wanted to end turmoil of mid-Tudor era and religious issues - Thus had a very stability and security focussed regime and policies - Resisted demands from court to be "Protestant saviour of Europe" - Intervened in Netherlands, Le Havre, Scotland to prevent Spa/Fra controlling all the nearby coast and/or having Scotland as an invasion base
